4 skinless, boneless chicken thighs 1/3 cup honey

1/2 cup soy sauce 3 cloves garlic, minced 1/2 cup ketchup 1 teaspoon dried basil

Directions

- 1 Lay chicken thighs into the bottom of a 4-quart slow cooker.
- Whisk soy sauce, ketchup, honey, garlic, and basil together in a bowl; pour over the chicken.
- 3 Cook on Low for 6 hours.
